

Handout – Examples for Two Truths and a Lie

Animal Facts:

1. **Example 1:**

- Penguins can't fly.
- Frogs can live in both water and on land.
- Elephants are smaller than rabbits. (Lie)

2. **Example 2:**

- Bats are the only mammals that can fly.
- Sharks have bones in their bodies. (Lie, they have cartilage)
- Some snakes can swim.

3. **Example 3:**

- Octopuses have three hearts.
- A giraffe's tongue is blue.
- Bees sleep all day. (Lie, they are active during the day)

Space Facts:

1. **Example 1:**

- The Earth is round.
- The Sun is made of rock. (Lie, it is made of gases)
- The Moon has craters.

2. **Example 2:**

- The Earth orbits around the Sun.
- There are stars bigger than the Sun.
- The Moon is made of cheese. (Lie)

3. **Example 3:**

- It takes one year for the Earth to travel around the Sun.
- You can breathe in space without a spacesuit. (Lie)
- Mars is known as the Red Planet.

Plant Facts:

1. **Example 1:**

- Plants make their food using sunlight.
- Plants need soil to grow. (Lie, they need water, sunlight, and nutrients, but not always soil)
- Trees help make the air cleaner.

2. **Example 2:**

- Cactuses can live in the desert without much water.
- All plants have flowers. (Lie, some plants don't have flowers)
- Trees grow from seeds.

Body and Senses Facts:

1. **Example 1:**

- Your heart pumps blood all around your body.
- Your eyes can see in the dark like a cat's. (Lie)
- Your bones help you stand up and move.

2. **Example 2:**

- You have five basic senses: sight, smell, taste, touch, and hearing.
- You use your skin to taste food. (Lie, taste comes from the tongue)
- Your ears help you balance.

Weather Facts:

1. **Example 1:**

- Rain falls from clouds in the sky.
- Thunder is caused by two clouds bumping into each other. (Lie, it's caused by lightning)
- The Sun helps keep the Earth warm.

2. **Example 2:**

- Snow is frozen water.
- Wind can be seen with your eyes. (Lie, you can feel it but not see it)
- Rainbows are made when light passes through raindrops.
