The general observations give a great overview of the area the student studied, how it fits into the broader landscape, what life forms dominate the area, what the overall impact of humans, the weather, and any invasive species are. Notices even subtle changes over time.
Detailed Observations	Not much detailed information provided. Did not spend enough time really analyzing the area up close	Noticed some relevant details, but could have gone more into depth. Makes not of at least one specific plant or animal.	Noticed several details, including at least one animal and one plant that are present in the area. Connection between general and detailed observations is at least hinted at. Notices some changes over time.	Noticed many details, such as the presence of ants, broken plants from footsteps, condition of soil (dry or wet) etc. Detailed observations fit with the general observations (reference is made to how these observations confirm general observations). Subtle changes over time are noted.
