Conditional Statement Ideas for the ScratchJr Animal Icons	

Dog	If (winter), then (dog gets winter coat) or If (summer), then (dog sheds)
Rabbit	If (winter), then (coat white) or If (Summer), then (coat brown)
Chicken	If (night), then (chicken roosts)
Elephant	If (dry season), then (elephants migrate to water)
Monarch Butterfly	If (fall), then (butterfly migrates)
House Fly	If (Cold or night), then (fly sleeps)
Bat	If (night), then (bat awake)
Bird	If (fall), then (migrate), If (spring), then (lay eggs)
Snake	If (winter), then (hibernate)
Lizard	If (sunny), then (basking)
Frog	If (spring), then (calling), If (winter), then (hibernate)
Duck	If (warm/sunny), then (duck will loaf in open area)
Fish	If (spring), then (fish lay eggs)
Whale	If (breeding season), then (head south)
Penguin	If (South pole), then (penguins live there)
Polar Bear	If (North pole), then (polar bears live there)
