Archimedes, reported to have designed the first simple elevator in 236 BC.






Roman Elevators:

An elevator in the Middle Ages.




Humans walk in a wheel to raise the elevator.



Elisha Otis

Inventor of the modern elevator

- Born in Vermont in 1811. Died in 1861 New York
- Inventions:
 - A robot turner while working as a doll maker
 - An automatic train brake
 - Automatic bread baking oven
 - An elevator brake!





Demonstration at 1854 New York World's




Otis stands on the elevator as the rope is cut.




The Otis Brake

- With tension on the cable, the brakes are pulled in.
- If the cable breaks and tension is gone, then the brakes slam into the side of the elevator shaft.
- Elevator stops almost immediately!


