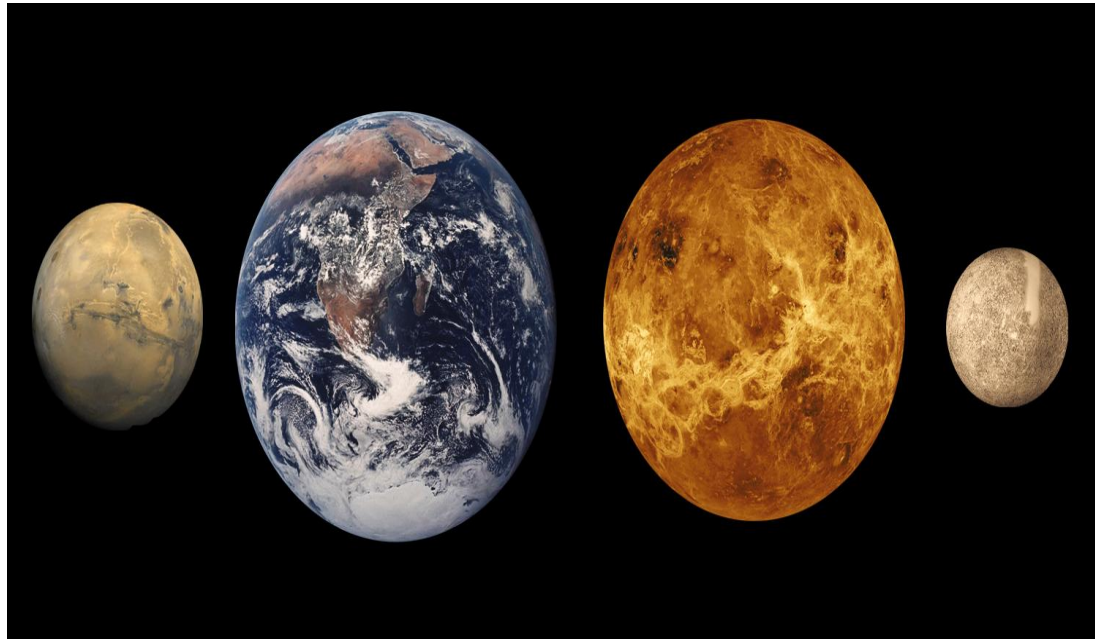
# Terrestrial Planets (or moons)

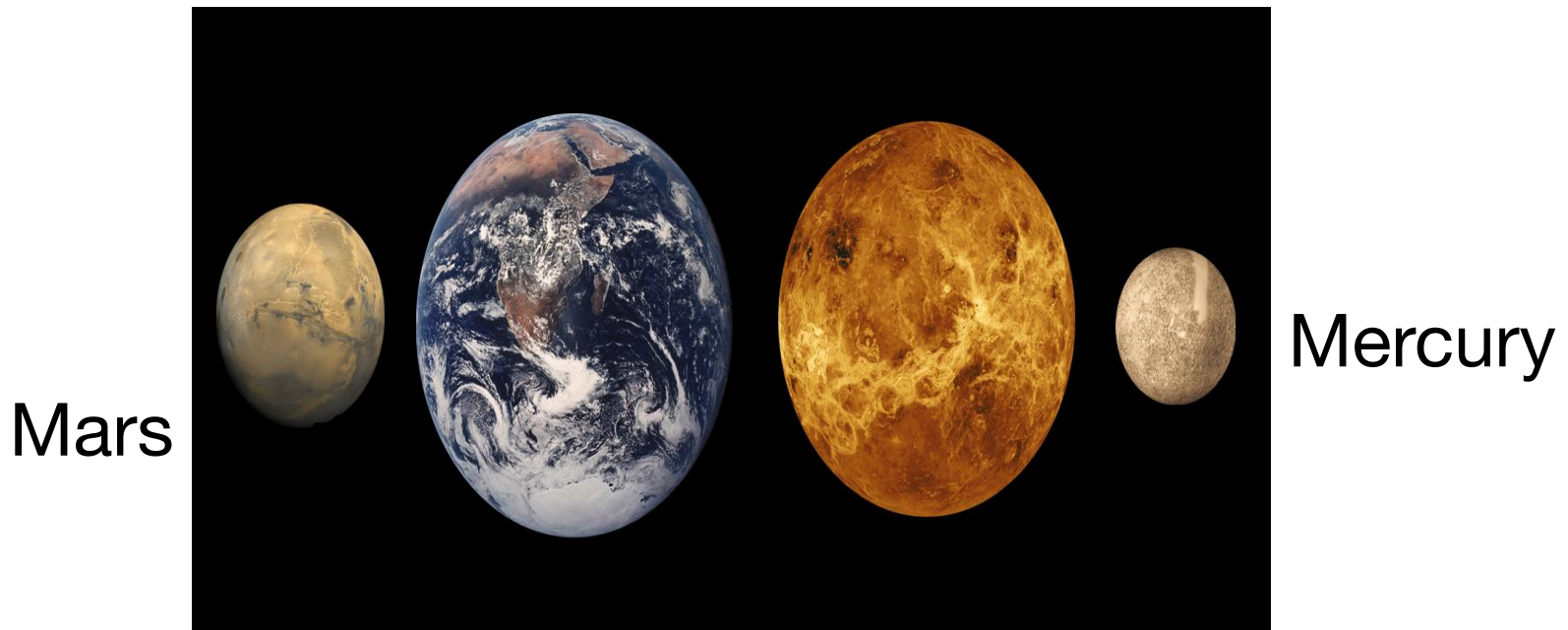

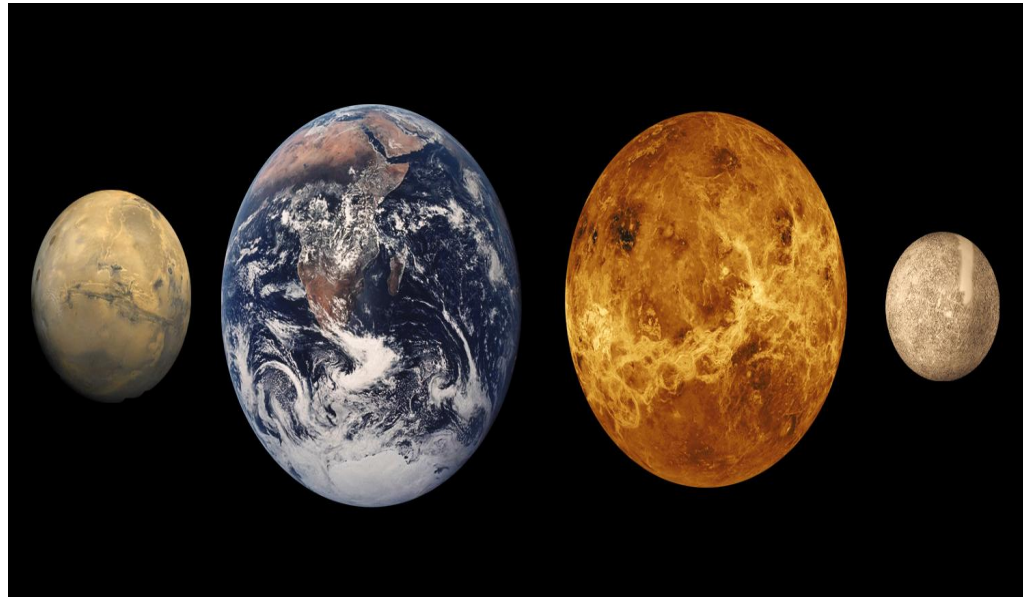

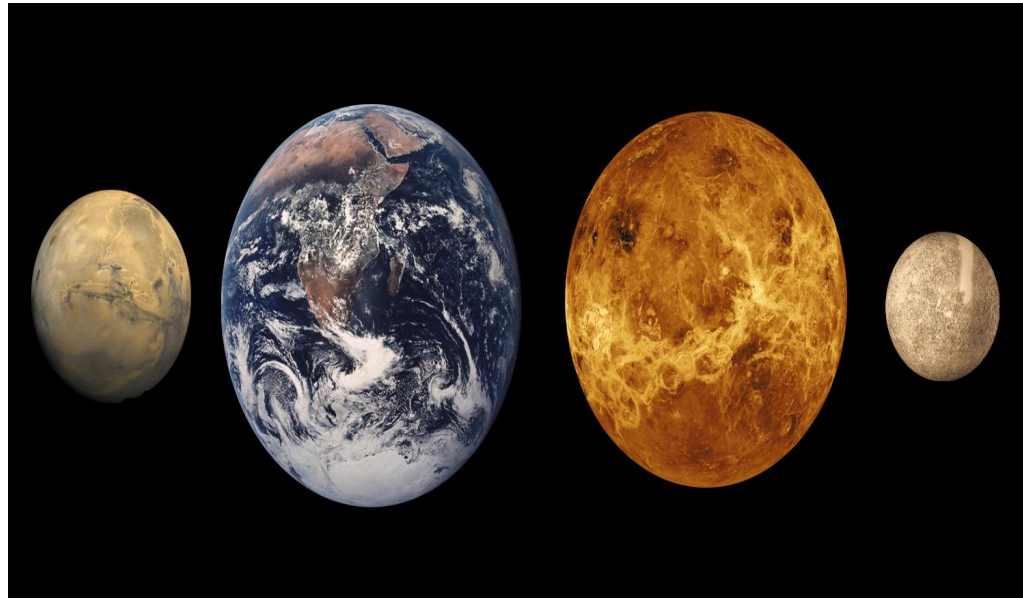

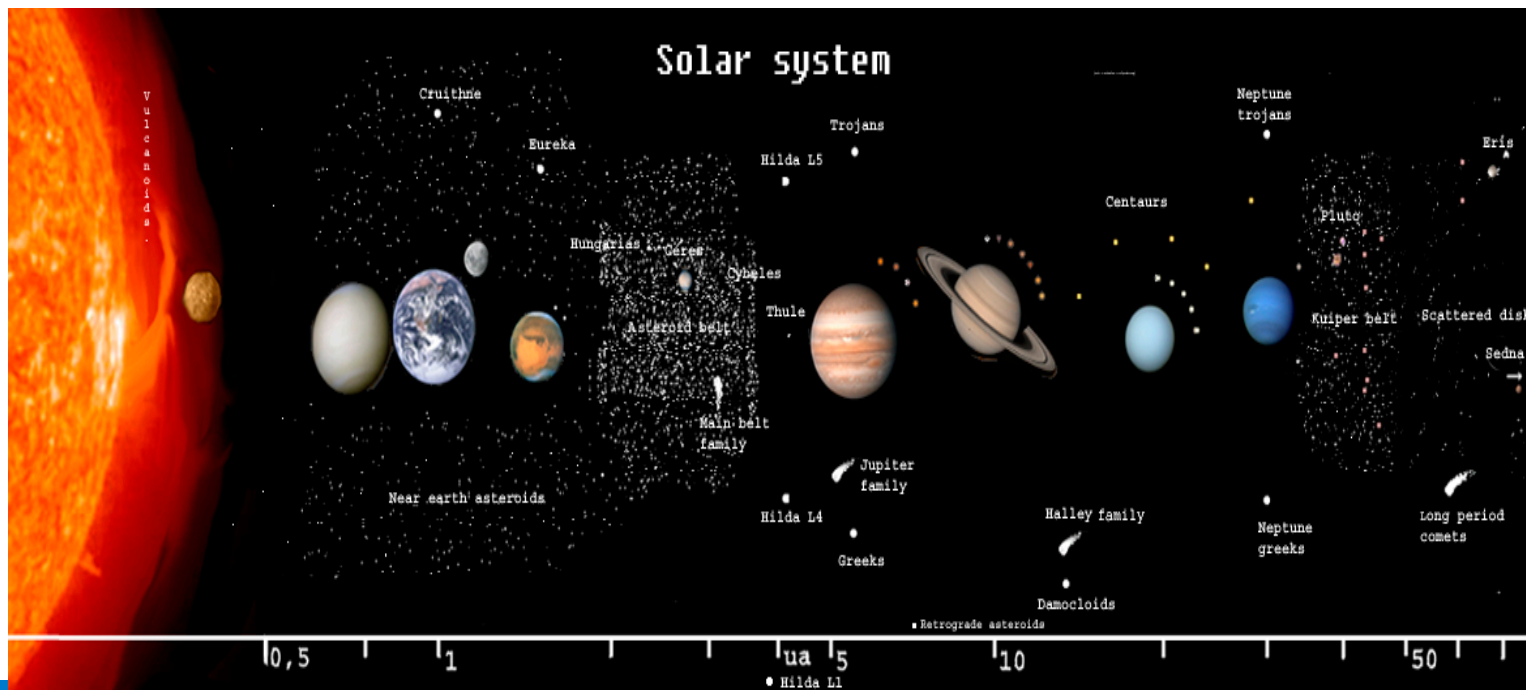


- They are all close to the sun (Interior planets)

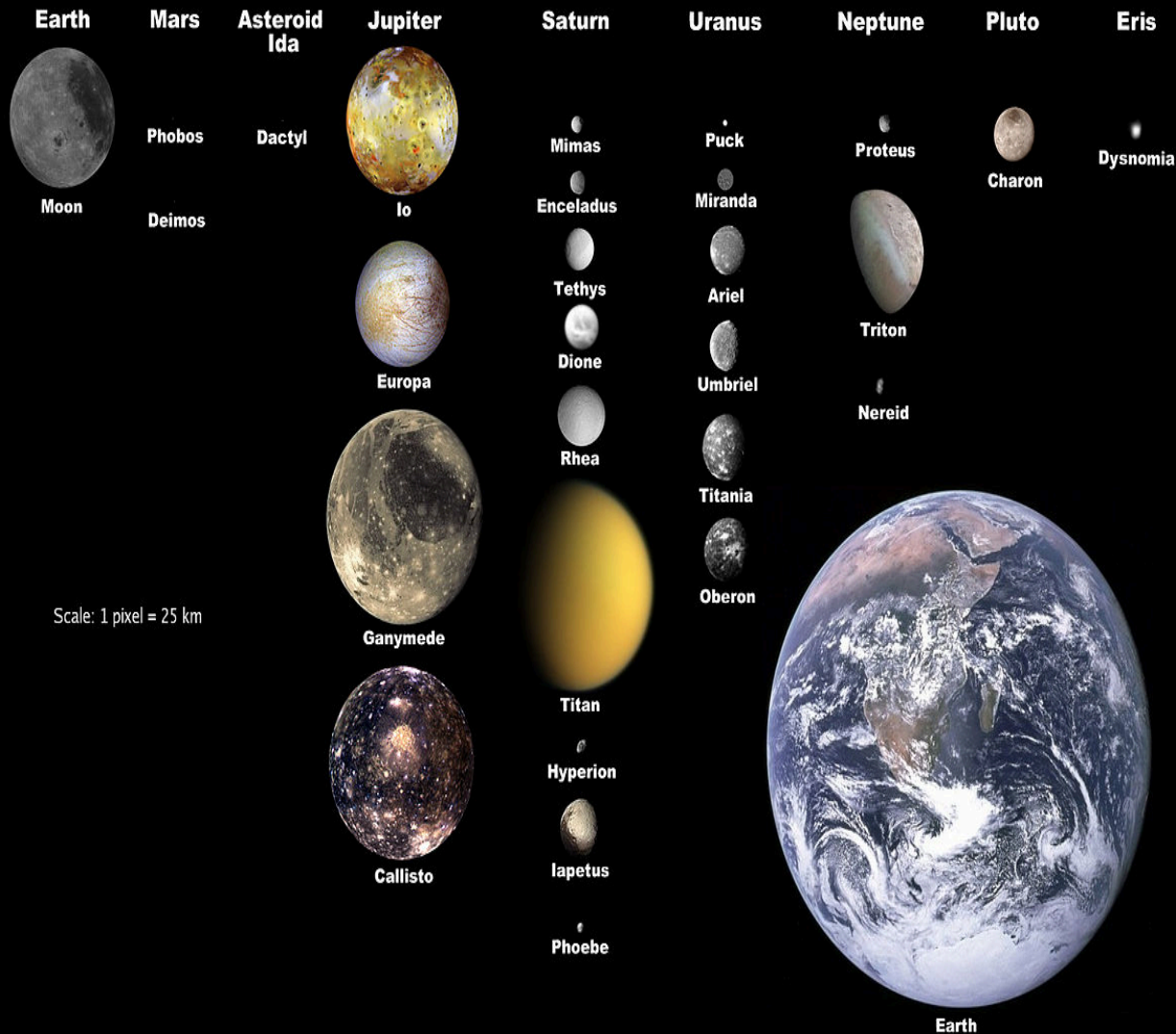
